He can use an adjective to describe a character or a setting. He is beginning to segment words into phonemes and make phonetically plausible attempts. His handwriting is of a consistent size and shape.

Augustus has made good progress in reading, particularly with the retelling of stories he has read. He is beginning to listen to himself when reading and check again for sense. He is reading a range of genres and now he is beginning to say which type of story he prefers and why.

When writing, Augustus should now continue to practise using full stops and capital letters correctly. He should also focus on using connectives to join simple sentences together to expand them. When reading, Augustus should continue to listen to himself and check that what he has read makes sense. He should also focus on answering questions about the text, to ensure that he has fully understood what has happened.

Mathematics

Augustus has been developing his confidence with maths over the last year. He is beginning to use his knowledge of the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables. He can add coins together to find the total amounts and he can see the patterns in shapes. He can talk about the properties of both 2D and 3D shapes. Augustus should now continue to develop his confidence by practising using various operations to solve number word problems, for example using column addition and subtraction.

Augustus has really enjoyed the science topics we have covered this year. He can name the seven life processes with some prompting and understands that these prove that something is alive or not. Augustus has enjoyed finding out about habitats and why certain animals thrive in certain areas. He can discuss the life cycles of both humans and animals and the effect that exercise has on our bodies. Augustus has enjoyed growing plants and talking about what they need to grow properly. More recently, he has also enjoyed creating a clown face from various textures as we learn about materials and their uses.

Augustus should now think about asking scientific questions and begin to realise that there can be many different answers. He could think about how he will find the answers to these questions using various tests and experiments.
