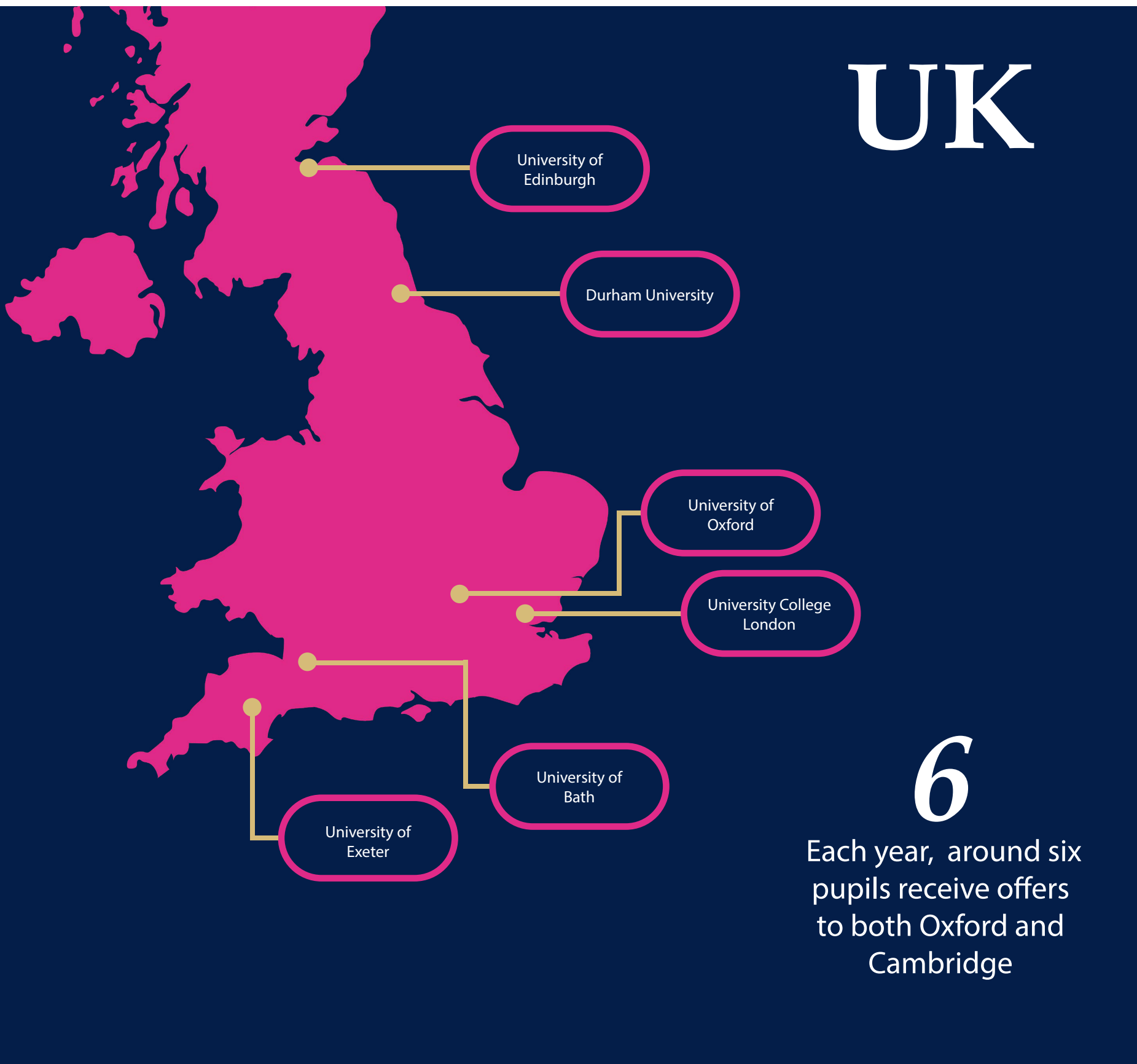

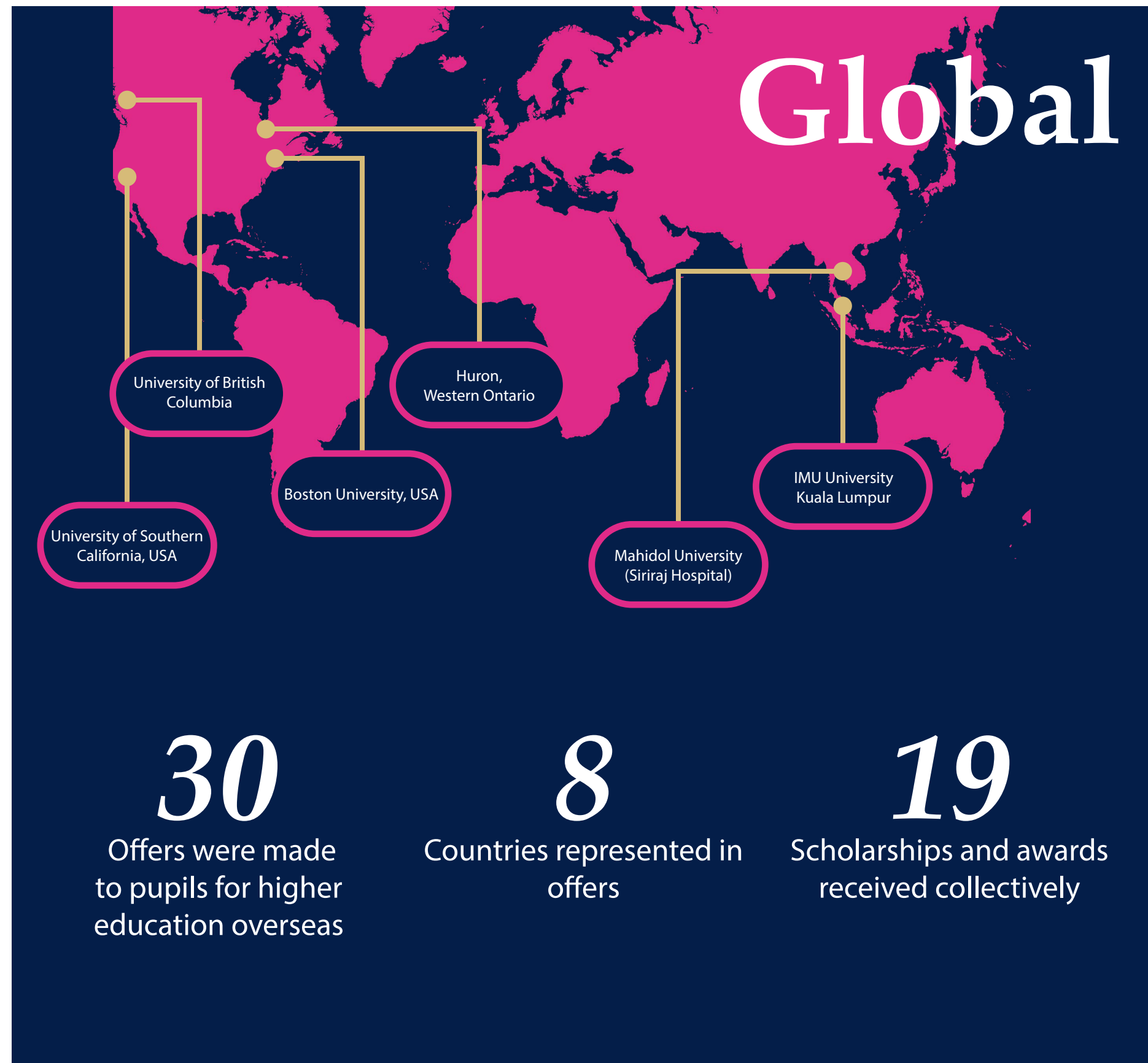

First International School

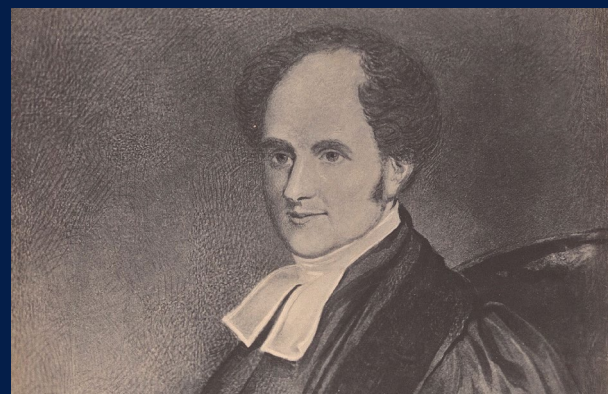
The Cheltenham College's first international school, Cheltenham Muscat, opens in Oman.

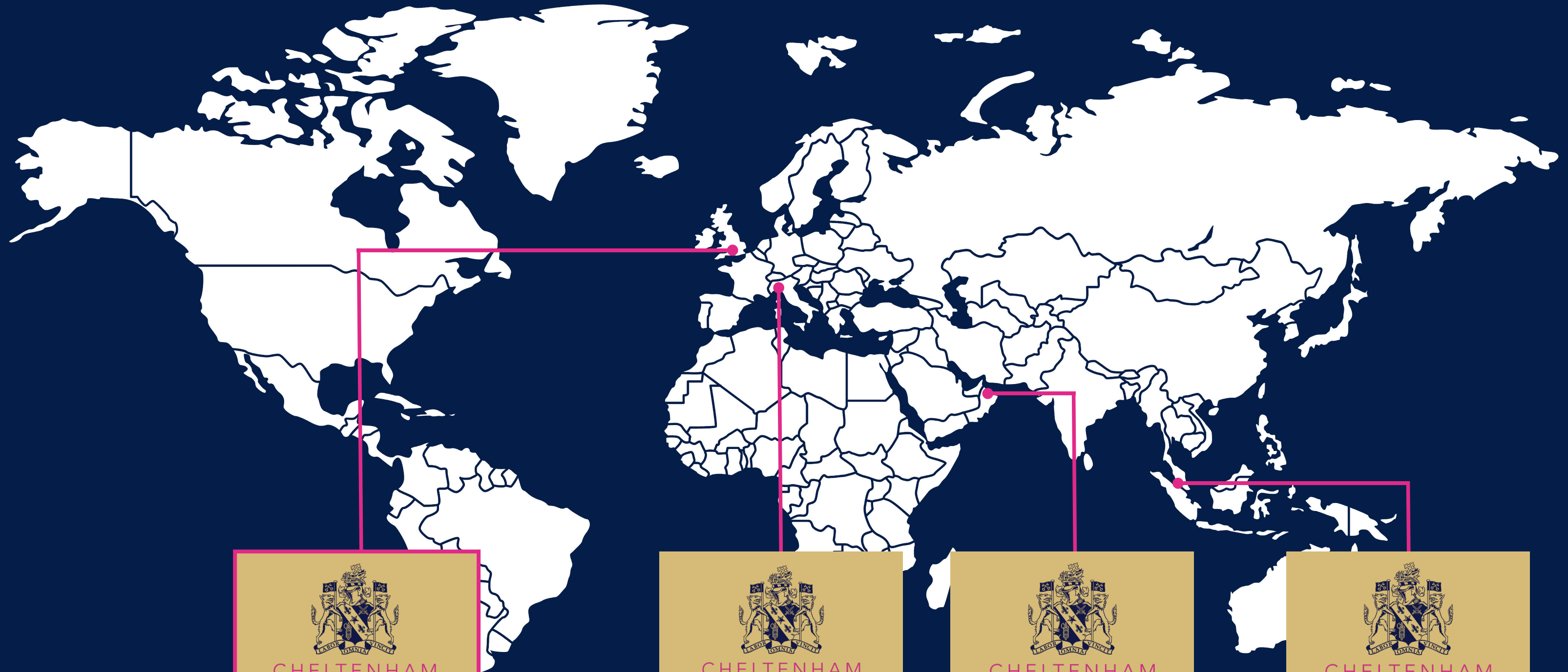
Rageh Omaar
